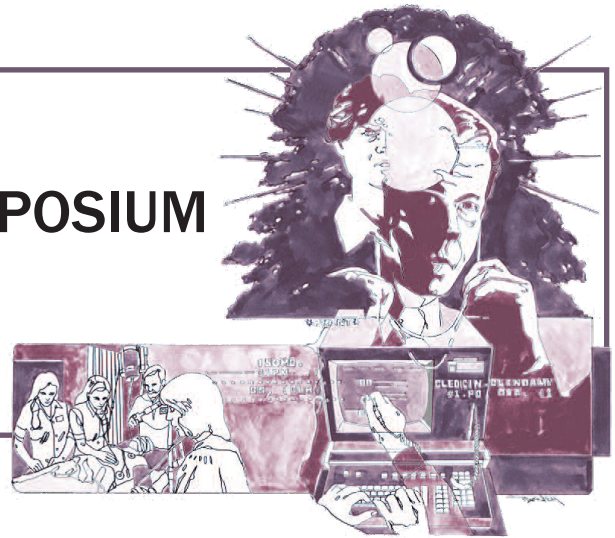

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Symposium Description

This two-day symposium is designed for critical care nurses, as well as other nurses and allied health professionals, desiring to enhance their critical care nursing knowledge base. An outstanding group of international and national speakers with critical care expertise comprise the faculty.

Objectives

- Articulate the pathophysiology of elevated intracranial pressure including causes, symptoms and nursing implications along with pharmacologic management of initial and refractory elevated pressure.
- Demonstrate an applied understanding of EtCO₂ monitoring.
- Recognize indications for targeted temperature management in critical care and discuss nursing implications and management as well as potential patient outcomes.
- Discuss the core interventions for the management of major hemorrhage and their underpinning evidence-base.
- Identify the risk for hemodynamic or pulmonary complications after general anesthesia.
- Discuss the impact of cardiorenal syndrome on clinical decision making.
- Discuss the indications for instituting family meetings, discussions and end of life care in the critical care venue.
- Identify high risk patients and clinical signs of obstructive shock.
- Describe the risk factors, clinical predictors and current evidence-based treatment modalities for venothrombotic events.
- Develop an understanding of errors in the ICU and potential evidence based strategies to prevent them.
